## Antarctic

### 1. Write a poem

### 2. Design a football kit

Imagine you are starting a football team in Antarctica. Design your team's football kit. What will they need to wear to be able to play in the cold weather?

### 3. Fact-file

Choose your favourite type of penguin and write a fact-file of information about it.

### 4. Animal habitats

Choose a different animal and make a poster that explains how this animal is adapted to live in its habitat.

### 5. Famous Explorers:

Do some research on a famous explorer. They could be an explorer of any country. Show what you have learnt as a poster or fact file.

### 12. How big is a million?

Like the penguin in the story, draw a picture or find a picture of a thousand of something — be creative!

### 6. Paper plate penguin

Use paper plates or paper cups to make your own penguin model.

### 11. Penguin postcard

Choose somewhere where penguins live to go on holiday. Write the adults in Year 2 a postcard from your penguin-spotting holiday.

### 7. Antarctic Art

Paint, draw or collage a picture of an Antarctic scene.

### 10. Prayer

Write a prayer asking God to take care of people who are exploring or who are on a journey.

### 9. Antarctic journey:

Find Antarctica on a map and find out how long it would take you to get there and what transport you would use.
