

Parents Questionnaire

Thank you for completing our recent questionnaire

Of those of you who took part:

- * **100% of you say that you feel welcomed when you come into school.**
- * 96% of parents agree that their child/ren are happy at school. The same number agree that school encourages parents to play an active part in school life.
- * **92% of parents said that they would find it easy to approach the school with a question or concern and feel that the school would respond.**
- * 96% of parents who responded to the questionnaire said they knew how to help their child with their homework.
- * **With regard to reading books and other material brought home by the children, only 72% were satisfied.**
- * 96% of respondents are satisfied with the progress their child is making at school.
- * **100% agreed that their child is taught well at this school.**
- * When asked if your child feels safe at school 92% agreed that they do. The same percentage felt that their child was well looked after while they were at school.
- * **92% of parents who took part in the survey believe the school achieves high standards of good behaviour and deals effectively with bullying.**
- * 96% of those who were questioned would recommend St Andrews to other parents.
- * **100% of respondents think that there are sufficient extra-curricular activities available.**
- * 100% feel that the school is well led and managed.
