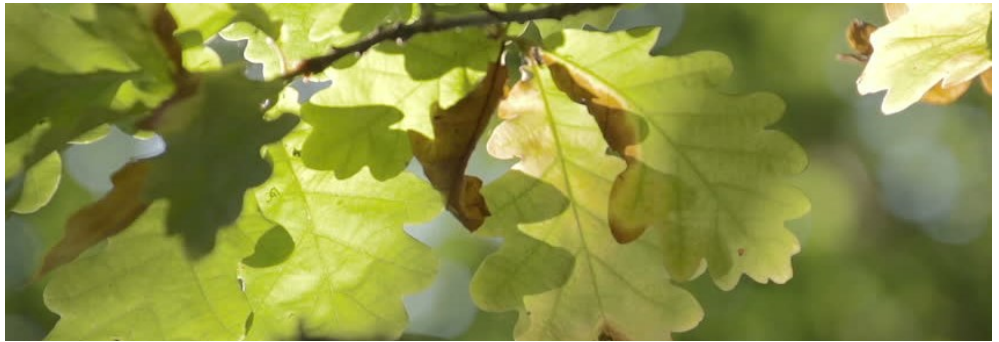

Please make sure your child is, as usual, clean tidy and smart.

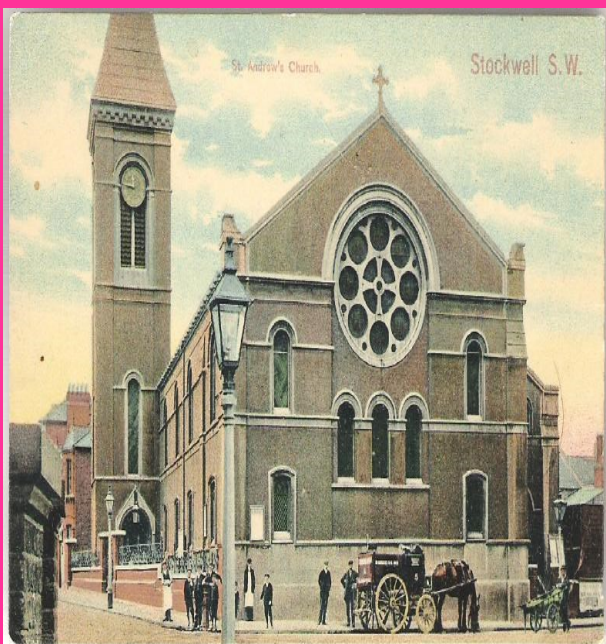
