1. DESIGN

Elizabeth wore lavish dresses. Can you design a costume fit for a Queen or a King? What materials would you use?

2. LETTER HOME

Walter Raleigh was a famous Elizabethan explorer. Imagine you have discovered a new country. Write a letter home describing the people, the climate and the environment.

3. SPYMASTER

Elizabeth I famously had a spymaster, Sir Francis Walsingham, who protected her against plots. Can you design a code for sending secret letters? Provide an example of one of these letters using your code.

4. PLAYWRIGHT

William Shakespeare wrote many plays to entertain the Elizabethan people. Can you create something that would entertain people now? It could be a play, story, or song.

7. FREESTYLE

If there is something about Elizabethan England that you are particularly interested in and would like to produce some work about, I would love to see it!

6. MAP MAKING

Create a map of London showing the locations of the Royal Palaces in which Elizabeth would have lived in her lifetime. Some of them are gone now but some are still around!

5. ARCHITECT

Tudor buildings were built in a unique and recognisable style called "wattle and daub". Can you create a model or painting of such a building?
