All our children were challenged to a competition, to design Building Health and Safety posters. There were lots of really great entries and after much deliberation, six winners were chosen.

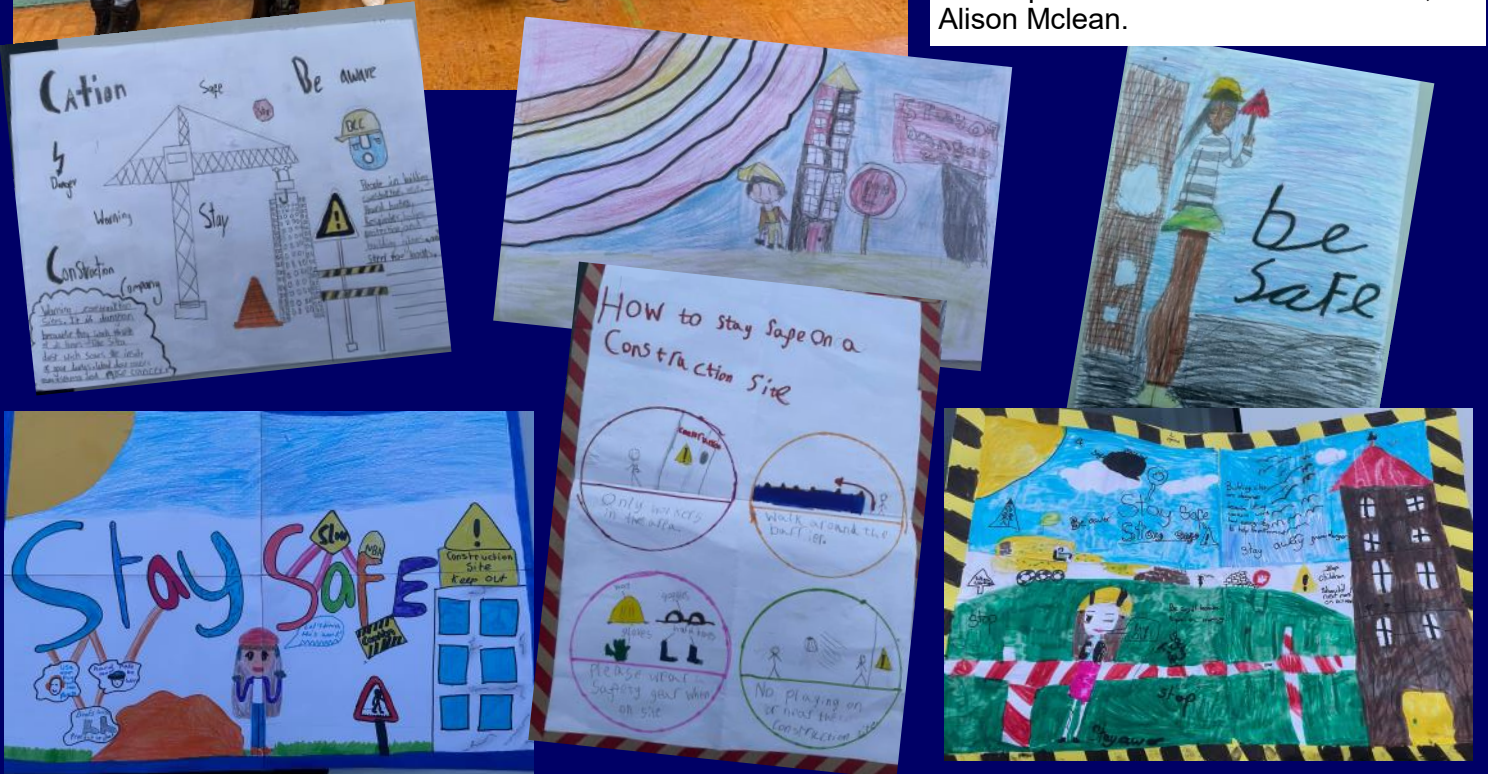
Each winner received a fabulous art set and an invitation to tour a local building site.
