Martin Kenyon 11/11/1929-07/09/2022



We are very sad to announce the passing of Martin Kenyon, who died peacefully at home, on Wednesday 7th September, aged 92.

Martin was a governor of St Andrew's, until he stepped down from the position, just a few years ago.

Best friends with the Bishop Desmond Tutu, he lobbied against apartheid, and for sanctions against South Africa when the then Thatcher government was opposed to them.

He was an old Etonian, a former army officer in the Royal Welsh Fusiliers and he met Queen Elizabeth II in the 1980's

Hailed as a national treasure after being interviewed outside Guy's Hospital, Martin was one of the first people in the world to receive the Pfizer jab.

Martin Kenyon was a much loved character We will miss his modesty, intelligence, charm and dry wit, which he always delivered with a twinkle in his eye.

We extend our sympathies to his beloved family.
