Late Collection

There has been an increase in the number of children being collected late from school. Parents are reminded that the school day finishes at 3.30pm.

While we understand that on a rare occasion you may be late to collect your child, this should not be happening on a regular basis.

Please be aware that the late collection of any child will result in a late collection charge of **£5.00 per child, per 10 minutes**, being imposed. This charge is to support the additional staff costs of out of hour's childcare, ensuring your child is looked after and safe until you arrive.
