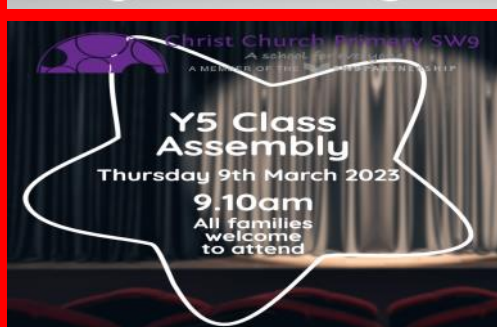
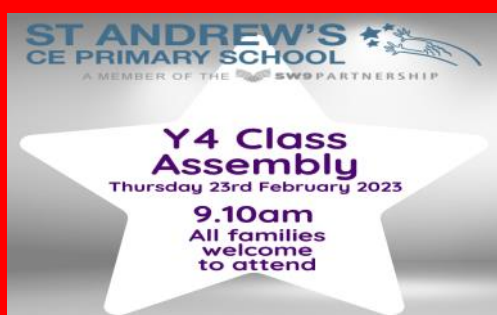

SPOTLIGHT ON GEOGRAPHY

Did you know that in the Early Years and Key Stage 1 (Y1 and Y2) our children begin to develop their knowledge about the world, the UK and their local area. The children cover a variety of topics including the UK and Caribbean, Antarctica and Australasia. They learn how to plot routes, use the compass points and read simple maps.

When the children get to Key Stage 2 (Y3 to Y6) they begin to learn how to locate the world's countries, they will also learn physical and human geography including about climate zones, rivers, mountains, types of settlements and land use.
