If you are experiencing difficulties paying on time, please let us know. We might be able to help.

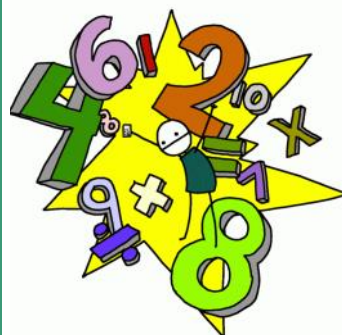
