

Daily Attendance Data Sharing

All state schools in England are now required to share their daily attendance registers with the DfE and recommended to share with local authorities, and academy trusts. This is so that the LA can know as early as possible when attendance is a concern and to foster partnership working to improve school attendance.

Education Law states: it is not a parent's right to take a child out of school during term time to go on holiday. Families must seek permission from the school and your school's Headteacher is limited in what they can authorise. The Headteacher can authorise leave if a child is in a performance and a performance license has been granted by the local authority. For any other authorised holiday, there must be extenuating circumstances therefore they cannot authorise a holiday because it is cheaper outside of term time.
