## Cultural & Family Attractions

**Southbank Centre Winter Festival**: Enjoy a range of activities throughout December, including riverside markets, food and drink, and a roller disco.

**Active Lambeth Christmas events**: Visit Santa in his grotto and participate in festive games and crafts at centers like West Norwood and Brixton Recreation Centre.

**Vauxhall City Farm Christmas Family Fun Day**: A free family fun day on Sunday, December 13th, from 10:30 am to 4 pm.

**Carols in the park**: Attend a free event on Sunday, December 13th, from 1:30 pm to 3 pm.

**Christingle Christmas market and carol concert**: A free event on Sunday, December 13th, from 1 pm to 5:30 pm.

**Bensons Children's Funfair**: Runs from Monday, December 14th, to Sunday, January 3rd.

**London Eye**: See festive lights and the city from above.
