CYCLE CONFIDENT

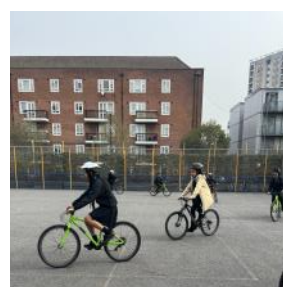
Y5 and Y6 Level 1 & 2 Cycle Training
