Year 3 and 4 Pedestrian Skills Training Thursday 4th June 2026

Pedestrian Training prepares children for independent journeys. One day of training for Year 4 Children in groups of 8 -10 children per trainer, for 45 mins of offsite, road side training.

The training reminds the children to
STOP, LOOK and LISTEN.

One day of training provided for up to 60 Children for Year 1 or Year 2 Children. Timetable permitting we will train 5 groups of 12 children for 45 mins, comprising 20 mins of games and activities on the Playground followed by 25 mins of offsite roadside training practising safe road crossing and pavement etiquette as well as identifying dangers.

Children will need to bring their own scooters if they have them.

A small number of scooters will be provided for children that don't have one.

The training includes:

- safety check of the scooter
- safe scooter control games
- pavement etiquette with pedestrians
- identifying scooting hazards such as cars reversing from driveways
- finding a safe place to cross the road and crossing with a scooter.

Holidays During Term Time

As we approach the summer months, we know that many families are thinking about travel and special events. All parents are able to request time off, but the Headteacher can only approve requests in very limited, exceptional circumstances - for example, if your child is performing and has a license from the local authority.

Unfortunately, reasons like cheaper travel prices, educational visits or extended family holidays don't count as extenuating circumstances and any holidays taken during term time have to be recorded as an unauthorised absence.
