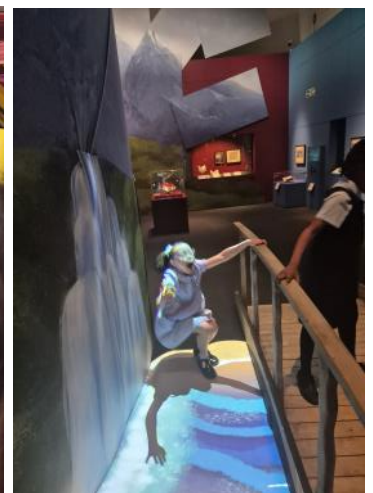


Our Reading Ambassadors at the British Library
